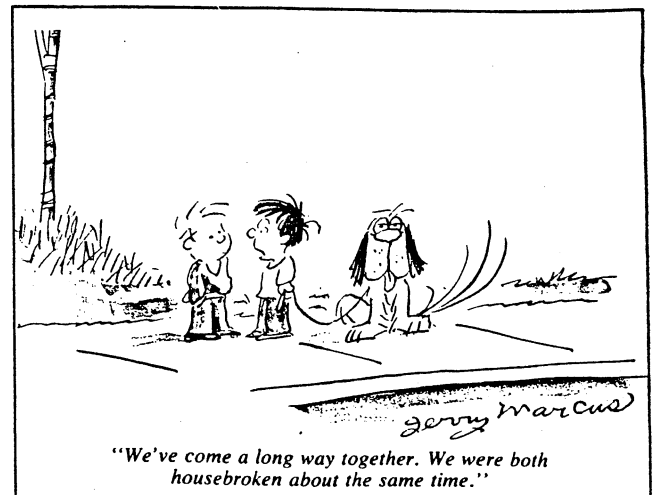
## spotlight

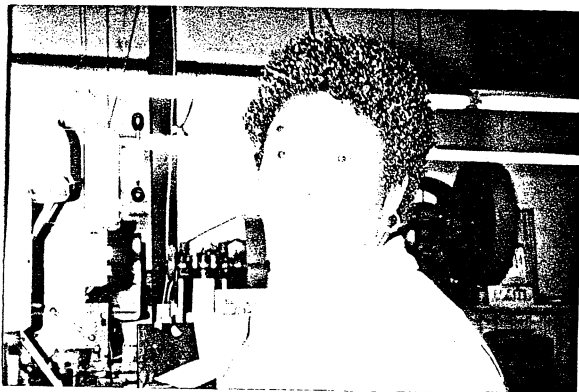

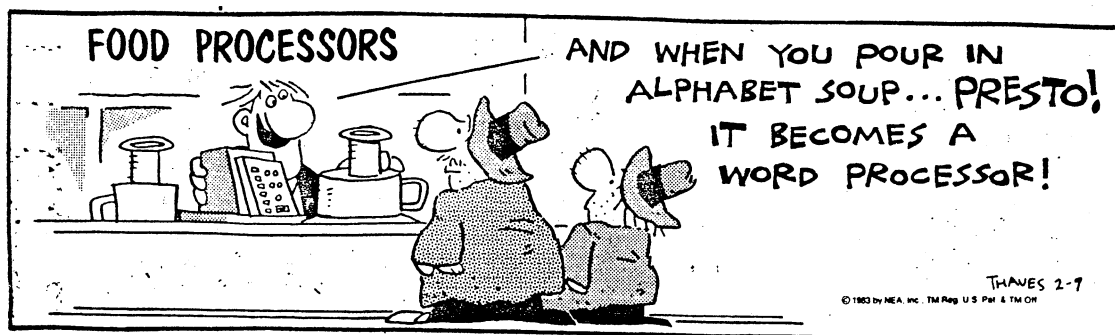
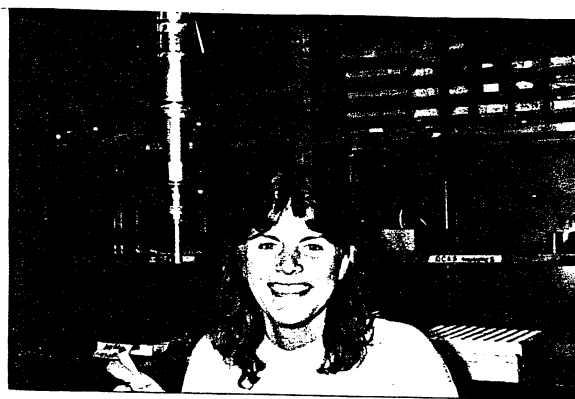

Pineapple Cake

2 Cups flour                                      1/2 teaspoon salt  
2 teaspoon baking soda                      1 1/2 Cups sugar  
1 can 20 oz crushed pineapple 2 eggs  
(Do not drain)

Mix together for about 2 minutes. Pour into greased, floured pan. Bake at 350 degree for 30 minutes. Cool for 3-4 minutes.

Frosting:

Boil for 5 minutes, stirring constantly.

1/2 cubes margarine                      6 Tablespoon milk  
3/4 cups sugar  
then add: 1 cup chopped nuts  
            1 cup coconut

Cool 10 minutes then put on cake.

Zucchini Bread

3 eggs    1 C Brown sugar, firmly packed  
1 C sugar    2 C zucchini, grated  
1 C nuts     1 C oil  
1 t. baking soda                                1 t. baking powder  
1 t. salt     3 t. vanilla  
3 C flour    1 t. cinnamon

Beat eggs, sugars, oil and vanilla. Blend in other ingredients, add zucchini, mix well. Makes 2 loaves. Bake at 350 degree F in well greased loaf pans.

Zucchini Bars with Caramel Frosting

Sift together:	Cream together:	Combine both mixtures. Gradually
3 C flour	3/4 C margarine	add:
1 1/2 t. baking soda	1 C brown sugar	2 C peeled and grated zucchini
1 t. baking powder	1/2 C sugar	1/2 C chopped walnuts
1 t. salt	1 t. vanilla	1/2 C butterscotch chips or
1/8 t. nutmeg	2 eggs	raisins
1/8 t. cloves		

Pour into greased and floured 10 x 15 inch pan. Bake at 375 degree for 20 to 25 minutes. Frost with Caramel Frosting.

Caramel Frosting:

1/2 C margarine                                      1 C brown sugar  
1/4 C milk    1-1 1/2 C powdered sugar

Melt margarine. Add brown sugar and bring to boil for 2 minutes. Add milk and bring to second boil. Remove from heat. Add enough powdered sugar to spread.

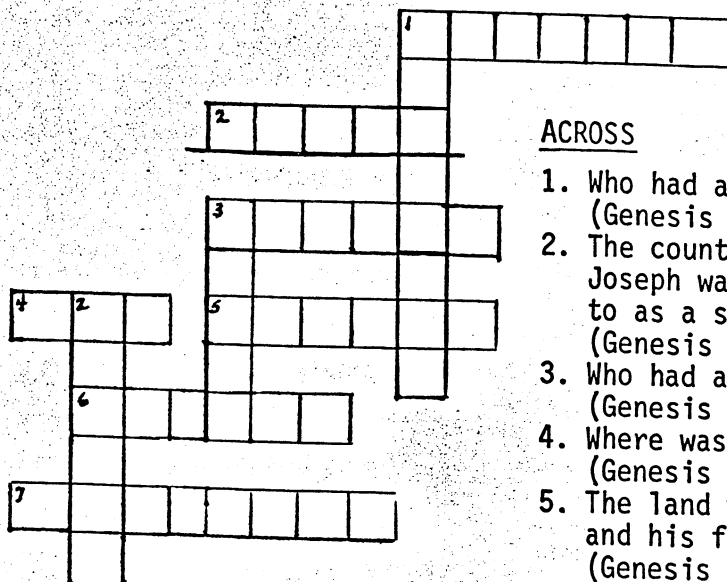
